



Kayak Roll Competition Rules and Waiver

Rules...

Kayak may be in roll position but may not begin the rolling movement until the start air horn/whistle has sounded. An event staff person will track the number of rolls completed in the two minute time.

A roll can enter from the left or right but must completely submerge the front and rear deck in the water to be counted. A kayaker may only roll one direction.... either all left entry rolls or all right entry rolls.

The kayaker must completely finish the roll for it to count. The kayaker is allowed to roll out of the water and reenter the water in one motion.

The kayaker may take as many attempts to complete the roll as needed but it will only be counted once.
