Participation Waiver

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Volunteers and children will then return to the UAW Hall to wrap gifts and eat breakfast. Children are to be picked up by a parent or guardian at the UAW Hall at 9:30 a.m. We look forward to spending time with your child and wish you the very best this Holiday Season.
